3.1 AddressBook Rest

The Addressbook REST project is a new REST version of the existing Addressbook SOAP webservice, with the same functionalities for consulting contact data. A new functionality to be able to consult the time of the last eHealthBox use of the consulted actor.

3.2 RNCONSULT – INSCRIPTIONSERVICE

Creation of 2 additional searches:

- get expired registrations list
- get active registrations list

3.3 STS IAM-STS-Saml11TokenService

Undeploy IAM-STS-Saml11TokenService end point

3.4 DaaS Pseudo

As part of the TRIO project, DAAS must be made PSEUDO-compatible. It is therefore a question of providing stakeholders with a new SOAP service "DAAS PSEUDO"

3.5 Evolutionary maintenance and corrections

- IAM STS WS Trust
 - STS service adaptation for duplicate attributes error handling
- Member Data MCN
 - infrastructure switch (ATOS -> Cegeka) for service IrisCareNet Member Data
 - No impact foreseen for external partners/package providers.




